

## GUIDE TO THE BLACKHEATH SQUASH CLUB LEAGUES

1. Log into the system (see the guide on booking courts)
2. Click on the "Leagues" Tab
3. You will then be able to see all divisions of the league. In this example, I am clicking onto a position in Div 2. I've played three matches but all were 0-3 losses (this happens - you'll have months when you're playing well, and then months when it's not coming together at all... c'est la vie!)

9. The next screen will then ask you how many POINTS you won, who your opponent was, and how many they one. NB this is not the number of points in the game, but relates to the number of games won.
10. The winner gets 5 points, the loser gets a point for each games won + one for turning up.
11. So a 3-2 win is recorded as 5 points to you and 3 to your opponent.
12. Click on "League Rules" to make sure you are fully conversant with the scoring rules.
13. If your opponent does not turn up or has been un-contactable through the month, you can claim a 4-0 points victory.
14. In the event of a 2-2 draw, you and your opponent can agree to (l) record it as a 2-2, one of you to record a win if they were ahead by a lot of points in the 5<sup>th</sup>, or to replay the fifth game from 0-0 another time.
15. Enter the score and click submit.
16. An email will be sent to the opponent to check the score entered.

League Membership

17. At the end of the league period, the league will be processed with the top two players from each division going up and the bottom two going down. Any players not playing any games at all, who have not notified the League Secretary with a very good reason, are excluded from further participation from the league. New entrants are then added, which may result in players staying in the same division, even though they were in the top two.
